- MPEG-2 Program Stream (MPEG-PS)
 - o MPEG-2 Video Codec
 - Progressive Scan
 - 4:2:0 or 4:2:2
 - MPEG-1 Layer 2 (MP2) Audio Codec
 - Stereo, 48 kHz, 384 kb/s
- Please encode with more bits than you think you need. For SD content, start with 8 Mb/s & up. For HD content, start with 16 Mb/s & up.
- We accept interlaced content, but prefer progressive scan.
- Please encode to a constant frame rate, not variable. No telecine or pulldown.
- Please do not scale SD up to HD.
- If you prepared an archive-quality master file with the properties listed above (and no filtering, splicing, cropping, or editing of any kind is required) your title's chances of timely processing increase.

In addition to the preferred format above, we gladly accept:

- MOV files (DV, DVC-Pro, HDV, XD-CAM, and ProRes)
- MP4 files (MPEG-4 part 2, AVC, AVC-Intra, and HEVC).
- DVDs and Blu-ray discs.
- Files as small as 640x360 and as large as 4k, but check with <u>encoding@aebn.net</u> if your content lies at either extreme.
- Files with standardized, constant frame rates (23.976, 24, 25, 29.970, 30, 50, and 59.94).
- If you work with other formats, please contact <u>encoding@aebn.net</u>.

Sorry, we do not accept:

- Unedited material
- Content without pertinent compliance documents
- Content with advertisements or excessive branding
- Any tape-based media or film.
- Split audio (dialogue in one ear, music in the other)
- WMV, FLV, RM, or 3GP files
- Vertically-oriented cellphone footage

Artwork:

- Front and back cover art must be present for each title submitted
 - Sent at the same time as the audio/video file(s).
 - Minimum width & height = 380x540 pixels
- We prefer print resolution BMP, TIFF, JPEG, PNG, etc. OK.
 - 300 dpi layered .psd files accepted, but only if accompanied by one of the above.
 - Send us any fonts as-is or in rasterized form.
